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








## Pathogenesis of NAS




#### NAS Births per 1000 at CHH


# Estimates of Total OUD using NAS Births as a Representative Sample





# Distribution of NAS Patients Admitted to Individual Treatment Units




#### **Estimated Charge Avoidance Using Specialized Treatment Units**






